Dear Ralph,

I am enclosing a manuscript that we submitted today to 'Cancer Letters'. It is based on work with your cellular fibronectin and, I think, some of the results are very interesting (although they are superficial in places, since the work was done by a student who had to leave at the end of the summer).

What will probably please you most is that cellular, but not plasma fibronectin inhibited invasion by ovarian cancer cells – at least in one line (SKOV-3). This supports your hypothesis that fibronectin may restore normal characteristics in cancer cells.

If there is anything you don't like about the paper, please let me know, so we can make changes when it comes back for revision.
